Phase 2 Graphemes

(A grapheme is the written representation of the sound or phoneme.)

Children will learn the following graphemes by sight with the help of the Jolly Phonics system. If you are unsure about how to pronounce each phoneme please see the phoneme pronunciation video. It is very important that phonemes are pronounced correctly in order to support your child with blending for reading.

Phase 2 Reading

Children will learn how to decode and blend simple VC and CVC words. (Where V means vowel and C means consonant.) They will be working on words such as it, on, sit, pat and top. You will find many words like these in the reading books your child brings home. Support your child to read them by encouraging them to say the sounds in the words and then try blending the sounds. Initially you might need to say some of the sounds for them until they become more independent. You will also find useful suggestions on the inside covers of the reading books.
