You may have noticed the defibrillator at the front of the school, which was kindly donated by Mr and Mrs Walsh whose son, was a former pupil of the school, sadly passed away aged 23.

In order to raise awareness within the community that there is a defibrillator on site, there was an article in the paper in the summer in which Mr Ludford said "The School are proud to be part of the local community and are really pleased to have been able to support the installation of this defibrillator thanks to this meaningful donation"

We want to continue raising funds to keep the defibrillator operational and are going to hold a Non-Uniform day on Friday 27th September in return for a suggested £1 donation.

This will allow us to buy new pads for the defibrillator, which are needed now and a battery when it needs replacing. It will also raise awareness that there is one on site, should it ever need to be used. Any surplus donations beyond the cost of new pads and a battery will be passed on to the British Heart Foundation.
